HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

Urging the adoption of youth special fares by all airlines in Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the existence of a youth special fare often spells the difference between a student spending the holidays with his loved ones or away from home in a nearly empty dormitory; and

WHEREAS existing programs for youth special fares have proven to not only benefit the student seeking inexpensive travel home but also the airlines which have them; and

WHEREAS the existence of youth special fares on all scheduled airline routes would serve to benefit the students who need them the most by providing inexpensive travel to outlying communities;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature urges the adoption of youth special fares by all scheduled airlines in Alaska and requests that favorable consideration be given all applications for these fares to the Civil Aeronautics Board.
