HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 19

Welcoming the VISTA Associates to the Alaska Legislature and commending them for their fine work in service to the state and nation.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS in recent years, growing numbers of American young people have dedicated and committed themselves to building a better and stronger America by working to eradicate poverty, by eliminating health problems and by helping people to help themselves; and
