HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 20

Proposing the repair of the White Mountain air strip.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the air strip at White Mountain, Alaska is essential to the local residents as a means of air transportation; and

WHEREAS the present air strip has been allowed to fall into a state of disrepair; and

WHEREAS the present strip will only accommodate single-engined small aircraft and there is a great need to improve the strip so that it can accommodate twin-engined aircraft;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska House of Representatives respectfully requests the Governor to consider the feasibility of extending the White Mountain air strip so that it will accommodate twin-engined aircraft and to repair the strip so that it is safe to use by both twin- and single-engined craft.
