HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 25

Commending the responsible young people of Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS students in Anchorage area high schools have recently organized themselves and other high school students throughout the state to promote a national campaign among young people to lower the voting age nationwide; and

WHEREAS it is encouraging and heartening to see young people taking the initiative to sponsor such a large-scale program which utilizes constitutional processes of reform; and

WHEREAS all too often all young people are condemned by their elders for the actions of a few; and

WHEREAS these young people in the Anchorage area high schools are to be commended for the maturity and responsible judgment they are demonstrating by their actions;

BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Sixth State Legislature commends the students of the Anchorage area high schools who are concerned enough about the political processes to originate and promote a national student campaign to lower the voting age.
