HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 31

Relating to implementation of the Human Resources Development Program.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS a large portion of Alaskans, particularly rural native residents, suffer serious handicaps in qualifying for and gaining meaningful employment; and

WHEREAS the traditional habitat of the rural Alaskan is enjoying new found prosperity;

BE IT RESOLVED that the State of Alaska, through the Manpower Training Division recently established by Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 174, am H, will immediately take steps to implement the Human Resources Development Program as proposed by the Coordinated Area Manpower Planning System (CAMPS), a committee of all state and federal agencies administering manpower resources.
