SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

Relating to a statewide land-use plan.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Alaska's greatest asset is its land, with vast areas available for habitation, recreation, development of resources, and wilderness areas; and

WHEREAS the tragic experiences in other states of misuse of their land and of conflicts among the various uses of land should prompt Alaska to engage in extensive land-use planning; and

WHEREAS at present Alaska has no statewide comprehensive land-use plan;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Natural Resources to begin work on a statewide comprehensive land-use plan, and to report to the Seventh Legislature, First Session on the progress of this work.
