SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 34

Requesting the withdrawal of the proposed game regulation restricting the use of wheeled or tracked vehicles in taking polar bear.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS wheeled or tracked vehicles are used for hunting polar bear; and

WHEREAS, since these motorized vehicles have supplanted dog teams, a restriction of their use for polar bear hunting will greatly reduce a much needed source of food and clothing; and

WHEREAS the proposed game regulation by the Board of Fish and Game would discriminate against those using wheeled or tracked vehicles as a means of hunting while allowing the use of aircraft for polar bear hunting;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature strongly urges the Board of Fish and Game to withdraw its proposed regulation restricting the use of wheeled or tracked vehicles in the taking of polar bear in those areas where aircraft hunting is permitted.
