JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the establishment of a post office at Ohgsenakale, Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Ohgsenakale is a growing and prospering village in south-central Alaska; and

WHEREAS the villagers are desirous of having and capable of managing a post office; and

WHEREAS a post office in an isolated village is utilized as one of the only contacts with friends and relatives in other parts of the country;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Postmaster General is respectfully urged to establish a post office at Ohgsenakale, Alaska.

COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Winton Blount, Postmaster General of the United States; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, and to the Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
