SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 6

Relating to a tax credit for the Rudolf August Oetker Company of Bielefeld, West Germany for the establishment of a brewery in Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the establishment of a brewery in Alaska will result in 60 to 70 new permanent jobs for Alaskans; and

WHEREAS the proposed plant will represent an outside capital investment in excess of three million dollars with the attendant boosts in economy accompanying construction projects of this magnitude; and

WHEREAS the initial years of operation of a brewery in Alaska would be a losing proposition, but that this situation will change in the foreseeable future;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature respectfully requests the Governor to direct the Department of Economic Development to give the most favorable consideration possible to the Oetker Company with regard to tax credits so that the establishment of this new industry in Alaska will be possible.
