## AN ACT

Relating to the discretionary suspension, revocation or limitation of motor vehicle operators' licenses.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 28.15.220(b) is amended to read:

(b) A court may as a part of the sentence for conviction of a violation of a state statute or a regulation adopted under a state statute regulating the operation of motor vehicles upon a highway or upon complaint of the department revoke, suspend, or limit a license, upon a showing by the department that the licensee

(1) has committed an offense for which mandatory revocation of license is required upon conviction;

(2) was responsible as a driver for causing an accident resulting in the death or personal injury of another or a serious property damage;

(3) has been convicted with such frequency of serious offenses against traffic regulations governing the movement of vehicles as to indicate a disrespect for traffic laws and a disregard for the safety of other persons on the highways;

(4) is an habitually reckless or negligent driver of a motor vehicle;

(5) is incompetent to drive a motor vehicle;

(6) permitted an unlawful or fraudulent use of his license;

(7) committed an offense in another state

which, if committed in this state, would be grounds for suspension or revocation;

(8) has operated a motor vehicle in violation of a limitation placed on his license during the period of limitation.
