AN ACT

Relating to the tax on watercraft fuel; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 43.40.010(a)(2) is amended to read:

(2) the tax on motor fuel used in engines for the propulsion of boats and watercraft of all descriptions, including that motor fuel which may be utilized for heating and cooking aboard boats and watercraft, is four cents a gallon, and

* Sec. 2. AS 43.40.010(b)(2) is amended to read:

(2) the tax on motor fuel used in engines for the propulsion of boats and watercraft of all descriptions, including that motor fuel which may be utilized for heating and cooking aboard boats and watercraft, is four cents a gallon, and

* Sec. 3. AS 43.40.030(a)(2) is amended to read:

(2) the motor fuel is not aviation fuel or motor fuel used in an engine to propel a boat or watercraft, including motor fuel which may be utilized for heating and cooking aboard boats and watercraft; and

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1971.
