AN ACT

Relating to real estate brokers and salesmen.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.88.041 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.88.041. QUALIFICATIONS OF COMMISSION MEMBERS.

(a) To be eligible for appointment as a member of the commission a person must be a real estate broker or associate broker who has been a licensed real estate broker or a licensed associate broker in Alaska for at least three years before his appointment.

(b) One member of the commission shall be from the First Judicial District, one shall be from the Second Judicial District, one shall be from the Third Judicial District, one shall be from the Fourth Judicial District and one shall be from the state at large. However, if no person is eligible or available for appointment from the Second Judicial District, then two shall be from the state at large.
