AN ACT

Relating to meat inspection.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 03.05.020(1) is amended to read:

(1) require routine inspection of food animals and poultry and derivative food products, to protect the public against fraud, disease and spoilage, and in this connection he shall promulgate uniform regulations establishing standards of identity and composition of these food products and minimum standards of sanitation and handling methods as to all phases of slaughtering, processing, storing, transporting, displaying and selling of these food products;

* Sec. 2. AS 03.05.040 is amended to read:

Sec. 03.05.040. INSPECTION. On any business day during the usual hours of business the commissioner or his authorized inspector may, for the purpose of inspecting agricultural products subject to regulation, enter a storehouse, warehouse, cold storage plant, packing house, slaughterhouse, retail store or other building or place where those products are kept, stored, processed or sold.
