AN ACT

Relating to declarations of candidacy for district-wide office; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 15.25.040(c) is amended to read:

(c) A candidate for state-wide offices shall file with the lieutenant governor. A candidate for district-wide office shall file either with a clerk of the superior court or the lieutenant governor. If the candidate files his declaration with the clerk of the superior court, the clerk shall immediately forward the declaration to the lieutenant governor.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
