AN ACT

Relating to the trustee's sale of real property under a deed of trust; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 34.20.080(a) is amended to read:

(a) The sale authorized in sec. 70 of this chapter shall be made under the terms and conditions and in the manner set out in the deed of trust. However, the sale shall be made (1) at public auction held at the front door of a courthouse of the superior court in the judicial district where the property is located, unless the deed of trust specifically provides that the sale shall be held in a different place; and (2) after at least 30 days' public notice of the time and place of the sale has been given in the manner provided by law for the sale of real property on execution.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
