AN ACT

Relating to the board of parole; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 33.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 33.15.015. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. The board shall hire an executive director who has training and experience in the field of probation and parole. The executive director shall serve as the executive officer for the board in the accomplishment of its functions. He shall serve the board at the pleasure of the governor.

* Sec. 2. AS 33.15.160 is amended to read:

Sec. 33.15.160. COMMISSIONER MAY DELEGATE ADMINISTRATIVE DUTIES TO EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. The commissioner may delegate all or part of the administrative duties and responsibilities specified in sec. 150 of this chapter to the executive director of the board.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
