AN ACT

Relating to electrical safety; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 18.60.580 is amended to read:

Sec. 18.60.580. MINIMUM ELECTRICAL STANDARDS. The Department of Labor shall adopt the 1971 published edition of the National Electrical Code approved by the American Standards Association, and the latest published edition as of August 5, 1969 of the National Electrical Safety Code issued by the U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of Standards, as the minimum electrical safety standards of the state.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
