AN ACT

Relating to a period of probation for state employees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.25.150(7) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(7) a period of probation not to exceed one year before an appointment to a position becomes permanent, except that a permanent employee receiving a promotional appointment shall retain permanent status in the service and the job class from which appointed for the duration of the probationary period, and may be demoted to his former class without right of appeal, sec. 170 of this chapter notwithstanding, but if dismissed from the service he shall have appeal rights under sec. 170 of this chapter;
