AN ACT

Relating to the public school foundation program; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.17.051 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 14.17.051. INSTRUCTIONAL UNIT ALLOTMENT. (a) The instructional unit allotment for each school district is as follows:

(1) If the school district is in that part of the state lying within the boundaries of election districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9 or 10 the district shall receive the base instructional unit allotment.

(2) If the school district is in election district 6 or 11 or that part of the state lying south of the arctic circle in election districts 15 or 16 and east of 152 degrees west longitude the district shall receive 105 per cent of the base allotment.

(3) If the school district is in that part of the state lying within the boundaries of election districts 12, 13, 14, 17, 18 or 19, or that part of election districts 15 and 16 west of 152 degrees west longitude, or north of the arctic circle the district shall be entitled to 110 per cent of the base allotment.

(b) The instructional unit allotment as determined by (a)(1) - (3) of this section for any school district which does not have access to Anchorage, Ketchikan or Fairbanks by road, railroad or ferry, shall be increased by a total of five per cent.
