AN ACT

Relating to the use of firearms in designated state parks; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.55.050 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(b) Notwithstanding the provisions in (a) of this section, firearms may be used in those state parks which are by statute, or by lawful regulation, open to shooting.

* Sec. 2. AS 41.20.230(c) is amended to read:

(c) Discharge of a firearm is permitted in Chugach State Park when authorized by lawful regulation by the Department of Natural Resources.

* Sec. 3. AS 41.20.280 is amended to read:

Sec. 41.20.280. HUNTING; DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS. Discharge of a firearm in Kachemak Bay State Park, when authorized by the Department of Natural Resources by lawful regulation, is permitted.

* Sec. 4. AS 41 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

CHAPTER 99. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

Sec. 41.99.010. GAME MANAGEMENT AND ENFORCEMENT. Nothing in this title denies the Department of Fish and Game or the Board of Fish and Game their management and enforcement responsibilities related to the fish and game of this state.

* Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
