AN ACT

Relating to the accessibility and usability of buildings and facilities at the campuses and community colleges of the University of Alaska by physically handicapped students; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 35.10.015 is amended to read:

Sec. 35.10.015. ARCHITECTURAL BARRIER REGULATIONS. The Department of Public Works is responsible for preparing and promulgating regulations governing the construction of public buildings and facilities by or for the state, including the University of Alaska, and its political subdivisions to insure that the public buildings and facilities are accessible to, and usable by, the physically handicapped. The regulations of the department shall conform as far as it is feasible to the publication entitled "American Standard Specifications for Making Buildings and Facilities Accessible to and Usable by the Physically Handicapped" or any amendments to this publication as approved by the American Standards Association, Incorporated, under the sponsorship of the National Society for Crippled Children and Adults and the President's Committee on Employment of the Physically Handicapped.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
