AN ACT

Authorizing teacher sick leave banks; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.14 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 14.14.105. SICK LEAVE BANK. A local school district board, or the board of directors of the state-operated school system, may establish a sick leave bank to enable a teacher, because of unusual circumstances, to draw not more than twice the number of days of sick leave the teacher has accumulated. The board may establish and administer the sick leave bank independently or jointly with teachers.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1971.
