AN ACT

Relating to the Alaska Bar Association; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.08.050(a) is amended to read:

(a) Two members of the board shall be elected by and from among the members of the association resident in the first judicial district; four members of the board shall be elected by and from among the members of the association resident in the third judicial district; two members by and from among the members of the association resident in the combined area of the second and fourth judicial districts; and one member at large from the entire state.

* Sec. 2. AS 08.08.050(c) is amended to read:

(c) Three board members shall be elected annually, on the following triennial rotation:

(1) in the first year, one member at large and two members from the third judicial district;

(2) in the second year, one member from the combined area of the second and fourth judicial districts, one member from the third judicial district, and one member from the first judicial district; and

(3) in the third year, one member from the first judicial district, one member from the combined area of the second and fourth judicial districts, and one member from the third judicial district.

* Sec. 3. The triennial rotation described in sec. 2 of this Act shall commence in 1971, which shall be the "first year" as

the term is used in sec. 2 of this Act. The present members of the board shall continue to be members until their successors assume office.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
