HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 8

Relating to the Southeastern Alaska High School Music Festival.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS Juneau was recently the host city for the Southeastern Alaska High School Music Festival, participated in by several hundred students; and

WHEREAS the opportunity to participate in such an event is a social learning situation and gives the students the opportunity to perform and learn under nationally known musicians; and
