## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 21

Relating to the 1972 conference of chief justices.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the State of Alaska has a chance to host the 1972 conference of chief justices; and

WHEREAS the Supreme Court of Alaska has already extended an invitation to the conference to hold the meeting in Anchorage; and

WHEREAS numerous dignitaries from America and abroad are scheduled to be in attendance at the conference; and

WHEREAS the hosting of this conference would be an extremely beneficial and educational undertaking not only for Alaskans but for the participants in the conference;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it enthusiastically supports the Alaska Supreme Court's invitation to the National Conference of Chief Justices to hold the 1972 conference in Anchorage, Alaska and wishes to extend by passage of this Resolution its own invitation to the conference to visit the State of Alaska.
