## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 34

Relating to the ratification of the 26th amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the United States Congress has passed a proposed amendment to the United States Constitution to lower the voting age to 18 in all elections; and

WHEREAS this proposal has been sent to the states for ratification;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Seventh Alaska Legislature hereby ratifies the proposed 26th amendment to the Constitution of the United States, lowering the voting age to 18 in all elections.
