AN ACT

Providing dental insurance coverage under the state's group insurance plan; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.30.090(1) is amended to read:

(1) A group insurance policy shall provide one or more of the following benefits: life insurance, accidental death and dismemberment insurance, weekly indemnity insurance, hospital expense insurance, surgical expense insurance, dental expense insurance, audio-visual insurance, or other medical care insurance.

* Sec. 2. AS 39.30.090(5) is amended to read:

(5) The state shall contribute not more than \$27.50 per month for each state employee covered. Another participating governmental unit may pay the cost of insurance for its employee and his dependents or may share the cost with the employee.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1973.
