## AN ACT

Relating to private and contract carriers.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 42.10.050 is amended to read:

Sec. 42.10.050. COMBINATION OF SERVICES. Every person, except as otherwise provided in this chapter, who, for compensation, performs a combination of services which includes transportation of property of others upon public highways is subject to the jurisdiction of the commission as to the transportation, and shall not engage in the transportation without a common carrier or contract carrier permit to do so. Every person engaging in a combination of services which includes the transportation of property of others shall advise the commission what portion of the consideration is intended to cover the transportation service, and the agreement covering the combination of services shall be in writing, and the rate and charge for transportation set forth in the agreement. The rates or charges for transportation services included in a combination of services are subject to control and regulation by the commission.

(b) No private carrier may transport property for compensation, except as provided in this chapter.

\* Sec. 3. AS 42.10.420(7) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(7) "private carrier" is:

(A) a person who transports by motor vehicle, with or without compensation, property which

is owned or is being bought or sold by him, or property of which he is the seller, purchaser, lessee or bailee, and the transportation is incidental to and in furtherance of some other primary business conducted by the person in good faith;

(B) a person who rents, leases, or otherwise provides a motor vehicle for the use of others in transporting passengers or property, but who does not provide, procure, or arrange for, directly, indirectly or by course of dealing, an operator for the vehicle.
