AN ACT

Establishing a narcotic drugs enforcement unit in the division of state troopers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 18.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 18.65.085. NARCOTIC DRUGS ENFORCEMENT. (a) There is established in the Department of Public Safety, division of state troopers, a narcotic drugs enforcement unit for the purpose of investigating and combating the illicit sale and distribution of narcotic drugs in the state.

(b) The commissioner of public safety shall submit to the legislature, within 30 days from the date the legislature convenes, a report concerning the activities of the narcotic drugs enforcement unit. The report shall include, but is not limited to, the number of arrests made, the kind, amount and value of narcotic drugs seized, the sentences received by narcotic drug offenders, and an overall view of the narcotic drug problem in the state.
