AN ACT

Relating to the time the legislature shall convene for regular sessions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 24.05.090 is amended to read:

Sec. 24.05.090. REGULAR SESSIONS. The legislature shall convene at the capital each year on the third Monday in January at 10:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time. Each legislature shall have a duration of two years and shall consist of a "First Regular Session" which shall meet in the odd-numbered years and a "Second Regular Session" which shall meet in the even-numbered years and any special session or sessions which the governor or legislature may find necessary to call.
