HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 1

Honoring Carl P. Nevenheim.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS long-time Alaskan, Carl P. Nevenheim, has recently passed away; and

WHEREAS for the past thirty years Mr. Nevenheim devoted his life to the betterment of Alaska and its citizens, both in public and private posts; and
