HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 4

Relating to the parking of motor vehicles on the University of Alaska, Anchorage campus.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS it has been determined by the Building and Planning Committee of the Board of Regents of the University of Alaska that some form of revenue parking is necessary at the Anchorage campus; and

WHEREAS the use of parking meters as a method of collecting parking revenue impairs the aesthetic appearance of the campus; and

WHEREAS parking meters have a higher initial cost and higher operation maintenance cost than parking stickers or other means of collecting parking revenue; and

WHEREAS the students and faculty of the university have expressed their preference for the use of parking stickers or an alternative means of collecting parking revenue other than by the use of parking meters;

BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives respectfully requests the Board of Regents to refrain from the use of parking meters as a means of collecting parking revenue.
