SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 11

Relating to the "Federation International de Ski" cross-country ski races.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS skiers from every point of the United States recently competed in the "Federation International de Ski" competition in Anchorage; and

WHEREAS these races determined the team that will represent the United States at the World Nordic Championships in Falun, Sweden; and

WHEREAS it was truly an honor for the State of Alaska and especially for Anchorage to be able to host such a prestigious event; and

WHEREAS it was the consensus of participants, officials, and spectators alike that this event was one of the best managed and run they had experienced anywhere in the world;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it extends its heartiest congratulations to all participants, officials, and the myriad of other persons who contributed their time and effort to make the event a truly memorable one for all concerned; and be it
