SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 12

Honoring Balfour J. "Bob" Logan.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Balfour J. "Bob" Logan, longtime prominent Alaskan, has recently passed away; and

WHEREAS he was known throughout Alaska as one of the state's most prominent marine engineers and surveyors who carried on a lifetime love affair with the sea, and at various times was engaged in many other private pursuits; and

WHEREAS throughout his career in Alaska he was extremely active in public affairs on both the state level and in his home community of Cordova; and
