SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 64

Relating to the safety of certain school children in Juneau.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS numerous Juneau children of school age reside in Switzer Creek and in the West Juneau area; and

WHEREAS these children must wait for their school buses each day at the entrances to Switzer Creek and in West Juneau at Cordova Street; and

WHEREAS these locations do not afford adequate areas for the children to wait for the buses without endangering themselves as well as causing hazardous conditions to the many motorists going to and from the respective areas; and

WHEREAS it is vital that steps be taken immediately to afford the children living in those locations areas where they can wait to be picked up with total safety;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Highways to do everything in its power, and to cooperate with the City and Borough of Juneau, to provide the children of Switzer Creek and those who are picked up at Cordova Street in West Juneau with safe waiting areas removed from the road and street respectively.
