SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 5

Commending Professor Robert L. Fletcher.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the concept of limiting entry to the commercial fisheries of Alaska is of major importance to the economic well-being of the state and to the conservation of the state's invaluable fisheries resources; and

WHEREAS the legislature is currently dealing with this vital issue; and

WHEREAS the constitutionality of any legislation providing for limited entry presents a formidable obstacle; and
