## AN ACT

Making a special appropriation to the Office of the Governor, office of telecommunications; making a special appropriation to the Alaska Educational Broadcasting Commission; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. The sum of \$1,500,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Office of the Governor, office of telecommunications, for a satellite transponder lease project to demonstrate the feasibility of satellite communications in Alaska, priority being given to satellite television.

\* Sec. 2. The sum of \$150,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Office of the Governor, office of telecommunications, for the purpose of establishing a public radio network.

\* Sec. 3. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Office of the Governor, office of telecommunications, for the purpose of providing television production costs for legislative coverage.

\* Sec. 4. If the production studio of the governor's office of telecommunications is transferred to another department, the appropriations in secs. 2 and 3 of this Act are transferred with the function.

\* Sec. 5. The sum of \$75,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Alaska Educational Broadcasting Commission to pay public broadcasting system earth station lease costs of \$25,000 each for educational broadcasting stations at Anchorage, Fairbanks, and Bethel.

\* Sec. 6. This Act takes effect July 1, 1976.
