AN ACT

Relating to zoning in state parks.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 41.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 41.20.025. ZONING IN STATE PARKS. (a) The Department of Natural Resources may adopt, in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), zoning regulations governing private property within the boundaries of state parks established under this chapter.

(b) Land patented to or under interim conveyance to a regional or village native corporation under the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (P.L. 92-203) which falls within a state park boundary is subject to the zoning regulations provided for under (a) of this section only if the affected regional or village native corporation consents to or fails to reject the zoning regulations within 60 days from the date they are submitted to the affected corporation.

(c) Uses existing on the effective date of this Act are not affected by zoning regulations adopted after the effective date of this Act.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
