HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 153 am

Relating to renovation of legislative space.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Pursuant to provisions of ch. 10, sec. 1, SLA 1976, the Legislative Affairs Agency is directed to accomplish the renovation of the second and fourth floors of the State Capitol, without removing the marble or destroying the historical character of the building, in time for occupancy and use by the press corps, lobbyists and legislature when it convenes for the First Session, Tenth Legislature, in January 1977.
