HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 8

Paying tribute to Willard Sele.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the members of the Alaska State House of Representatives join with family and friends in mourning the passing of a fellow Alaskan, Willard Sele, whose spirit and self-sacrifice were greatly admired by all who associated with him; and

WHEREAS Willard's concern for his community was most recently highlighted by his service as Mayor of Haines from 1969 to 1975, although he also served on the Common Council from 1956 to 1959, and the Haines School Board from 1962 to 1968; and

WHEREAS Willard was active in other community activities, serving as a past Commander of American Legion Lynn Canal Post No. 12 and past president of the Mayors Association of Alaska in addition to being a charter member of The Bills Club and president of that club from 1960 to 1961;
