SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 107

Paying tribute to Jim McKeown.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the members of the Alaska State Legislature are saddened to learn of the sudden death of James R. McKeown, whose friendship and leadership in business will be missed by all who knew and worked with him; and

WHEREAS Jim, born in Tacoma, Washington, was a graduate of the University of Portland; first working with Boeing as an industrial engineer and then serving Alaska's Department of Revenue before entering the insurance business; and

WHEREAS Jim's business leadership and abilities were recognized by his election last October as president of Rollins Burdick Hunter of Alaska, Inc., after serving with the firm and its predecessor, LaBow, Haynes of Alaska, Inc.; and
