## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 81

Relating to designating Mile 5 Road in Cordova as a state highway.

\*\*\*\*\*

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the roadway near Cordova known as the Mile 5 Road is without maintenance and snow removal; and

WHEREAS, due to lack of maintenance, a school bus is unable to provide service to the 14 children of the approximately 30 persons residing adjacent to this roadway; and

WHEREAS the upgrading and maintenance of this roadway would permit school bus service and otherwise improve the economic and general welfare of the people of this state;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it respectfully requests the Governor to direct the Department of Highways to designate Mile 5 Road as part of the state highway system.
