SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 8

Relating to an interim study on state requirements for fire extinguishing equipment in buildings.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the Legislature has had before it this year various versions of House Bill No. 468 which relates to state requirements for the installation of fire extinguishing equipment in certain buildings; and

WHEREAS the complexity and importance of this proposal deserves an interim review and report;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Senate that the Legislative Affairs Agency is directed to review the subject matter of House Bill No. 468, consult with the state Fire Marshal as to the views of his office on the proposal, and report the Agency's findings and suggested legislation to the First Session of the Tenth Legislature.
