AN ACT

Requiring that the voter himself deposit his ballot in the ballot box.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 15.15.260 is amended to read:

Sec. 15.15.260. PLACING BALLOT IN BALLOT BOX BY VOTER. When the voter has marked his ballot, he shall inform the judge. The lieutenant governor may require that the voter return the ballot to the judge temporarily so that any stub which may be part of the ballot may be removed by the judge. Any such requirement shall protect the secrecy of the ballot. In all cases the ballot shall be deposited in the ballot box by the voter himself in the presence of the judge unless the voter requests the judge to deposit the ballot on his behalf. Separate ballot boxes may be used for separate ballots.
