AN ACT

Making special appropriations with respect to certain utilities and the Legislative Council; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* ~~Section 1.~~ The sum of ~~\$356,693~~ is appropriated from the general fund as a grant to the City of Nome to reimburse Nome Joint Utilities, a municipal utility system of the city, for extraordinary capital expenditures incurred by it in response to the natural disaster of November 14, 1974, and which have not been otherwise provided for from federal and state sources.

* Sec. 2. The sum of \$267,743 is appropriated from the general fund to be apportioned as follows:

(1) \$52,743 to the City of Seward to reimburse the city for its expenditures to meet extraordinary expenses incurred as a result of damage to the city transmission line on May 18, 1977;

(2) \$140,000 to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to relocate the principal transmission line serving the City of Seward in conjunction with realignment of the roadway at Mile 18.1 of the Seward Highway;

(3) \$75,000 to the Legislative Council for an interim study of rural energy needs.

* Sec. 3. The unexpended and unobligated portion of the appropriation made in sec. 2(2) of this Act lapses into the general fund June 30, 1979.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
