AN ACT

Relating to a regent appointed from the student body of the University of Alaska to serve on the Board of Regents of the University of Alaska; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.40.130 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

(b) In addition to satisfying the requirements of (a) of this section, the regent appointed under sec. 150(b) of this chapter must

(1) be enrolled as a full-time student at the University of Alaska at the time of appointment;

(2) remain a full-time student while serving.

(c) Failure of the regent appointed under sec. 150(b) of this chapter to remain enrolled as a full-time student at the University of Alaska during his term results in forfeiture of that office.

(d) The governor shall appoint a successor from those students appearing upon the list of nominees submitted to him under sec. 150(b) of this chapter within 60 days of a forfeiture or vacancy in the office.

(e) For purposes of this section, the term "full-time student" is defined as provided in the University of Alaska Academic Regulations.

* Sec. 2. AS 14.40.150(b) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(b) At least one member of the Board of Regents must be a student. The student shall be appointed from a list of

nominees submitted to the governor. The governor shall make his appointment from the list within 60 days after it is submitted to him. The list shall consist of the names of two students from each campus of the University of Alaska after an election is held at each campus. Elections shall be conducted under rules established by the Office of the Governor. The term of office of the regent appointed from the general student body, University of Alaska, is for two years. An appointment made under sec. 130(d) of this chapter shall be for the unexpired term of the original appointee. The term "campus" used in this subsection means a portion of the University of Alaska designated as a "campus" by the Board of Regents.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
