AN ACT

Relating to matters of public information.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.51 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 39.51.020. OBSTRUCTION OF ACCESS TO PUBLIC INFORMATION. (a) No public employee may be dismissed, demoted or suspended, laid off or otherwise made subject to any disciplinary action for communicating matters of public record or information under AS 09.25.110 and 09.25.120.

(b) As used in this section, "public employee" means any employee receiving compensation for services provided to the state (including the University of Alaska) or any political subdivision of the state.

(c) A violation of this section is a misdemeanor.
