AN ACT

Relating to the sale of subsistence-caught fish eggs; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Section 4, ch. 99, SLA 1975 is amended to read:

Sec. 4. Sections 1(a) and 2 of this Act expire January 1, 1978.

* Sec. 2. The Department of Fish and Game shall, no later than January 10, 1978, recommend to the legislature that the sale of subsistence-caught salmon eggs be permitted or prohibited. The individualized recommendations for each fishing unit or subunit shall be supported by factual documentation. The Department of Public Safety shall assist in gathering the documentation.

* Sec. 3. Section 1 of this Act is retroactive to January 1, 1977.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
