## AN ACT

Authorizing the division of tourism to make matching grants to promote conventions and incentive travel.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 44.33 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 44.33.145. GRANTS FOR PROMOTING CONVENTIONS AND INCENTIVE TRAVEL. (a) A nonprofit organization funded in whole or in part by a municipality to promote conventions in or incentive travel to Alaska is eligible to receive matching money for use in promoting conventions and incentive travel. Upon application to and approval by the director of the division of tourism, funds shall be granted as a 50 per cent matching grant.

(b) For the purposes of (a) of this section, "incentive travel" means travel undertaken by a group of persons into Alaska which is funded in whole or in part by a firm which provides the trip as a bonus or reward for performance on the part of either the firm's employees or its customers.
