AN ACT

Relating to fees for vendors of commercial fishing licenses;
and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05.470 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.470. FEE FOR ISSUANCE OF LICENSES. A person appointed and authorized by the commissioner of revenue to sell licenses under secs. 440 - 720 of this chapter, except salaried employees of the state, shall retain the sum of 15 per cent of the fee for the issuance of a license. A deputy shall transmit monthly to the commissioner all fees collected by him, less the authorized commission, together with a full accounting of the fees. The commissioner shall make monthly remittances of the fees collected to the proper state official. The commissioner is not liable for defalcation or failure to account for the fees collected by a deputy, but he shall require a bond in the sum he considers adequate, conditioned upon the faithful accounting of money collected.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1978.
